INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. Attention Exhibitors

Tree Towns Boxer Club and Mid-West Boxer Club, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children no under control of their parents or guardians.

There will be no refund for duplicate entries. All Prizes must be claimed the day of the show, none will be mailed.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

Dogs allowed in rings for judging only.

No entry fees will be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. Entries will not be refunded for bitches that come into season after entries close.

Refund for bitches in season. The club will refund the entry fees minus a \$10 processing fee for bitches entered in Obedience or Rally that come in season after the closing date of these trials. Refunds may be obtained by providing a veterinarian's certificate to the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start of the trial.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, dangerous weather conditions, Acts of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the club. No entry shall be made or accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance, and will not be accepted without fees or signatures. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Trial Guidelines for the Well-being of All Participants

During this period of concern due to the coronavirus, both clubs are monitoring the safety guidelines set by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC). To make for safe and enjoyable trials, Tree Towns Boxer Club and Mid-West Boxer Club will adhere to local, state, federal, and CDC guidelines or recommendations. The guidelines are subject to change and therefore, guidelines for the trial are also subject to change.

Guidelines:

- Exhibitors WILL be able to crate dogs inside the building.
- Masks will NOT be required when in the ring with your Boxer.
- Masks will only be required when in the building and NOT in the ring IF 6 feet of social distancing can't be maintained.
- The judge will NOT be wearing a mask in the ring. She will maintain a safe distance.
- Stewards MAY or MAY NOT be wearing masks and WILL maintain a safe distance when in the ring if not wearing a mask.
- To allow for crating inside, if possible, only those exhibitors entered in the trial should be at the trial site unless the handler requires physical assistance themselves, assistance with dogs, or the non-exhibitor is helping to steward.
- All in attendance MUST maintain 6 feet of social distancing at all times OR wear a mask. This includes in the parking area, restroom area, dog potty area, inside the building.
- To allow enough crating space inside, we need to limit the number of chairs.
- Per AKC recommendations, any class that requires a Figure 8, stewards will be replaced by either chairs, cones or uprights during the exercise.
- Gloves and/or hand sanitizer, and possibly a grabber device, will be used to ensure the safety of the judge, stewards and exhibitors. This includes the steward during the scent and directed retrieve exercises.
- For the Novice sit/down group exercise, the handler/dogs MAY be 8 feet apart instead of 6. This will be at the discretion of the judge and number of dogs in the class.
- All exhibitors will need to bring their own lunch. If social distance can't be maintained, you may be asked to eat at your car.

1 block to entrance.

From the South:

North on Route 31, left on Ringwood Road (watch for overhead stoplight).
1 block to entrance.

From the West:

East on Route 120, left on Ringwood Road, through two (2) 4-way stops,
1 block past second 4-way stop.

From the East:
